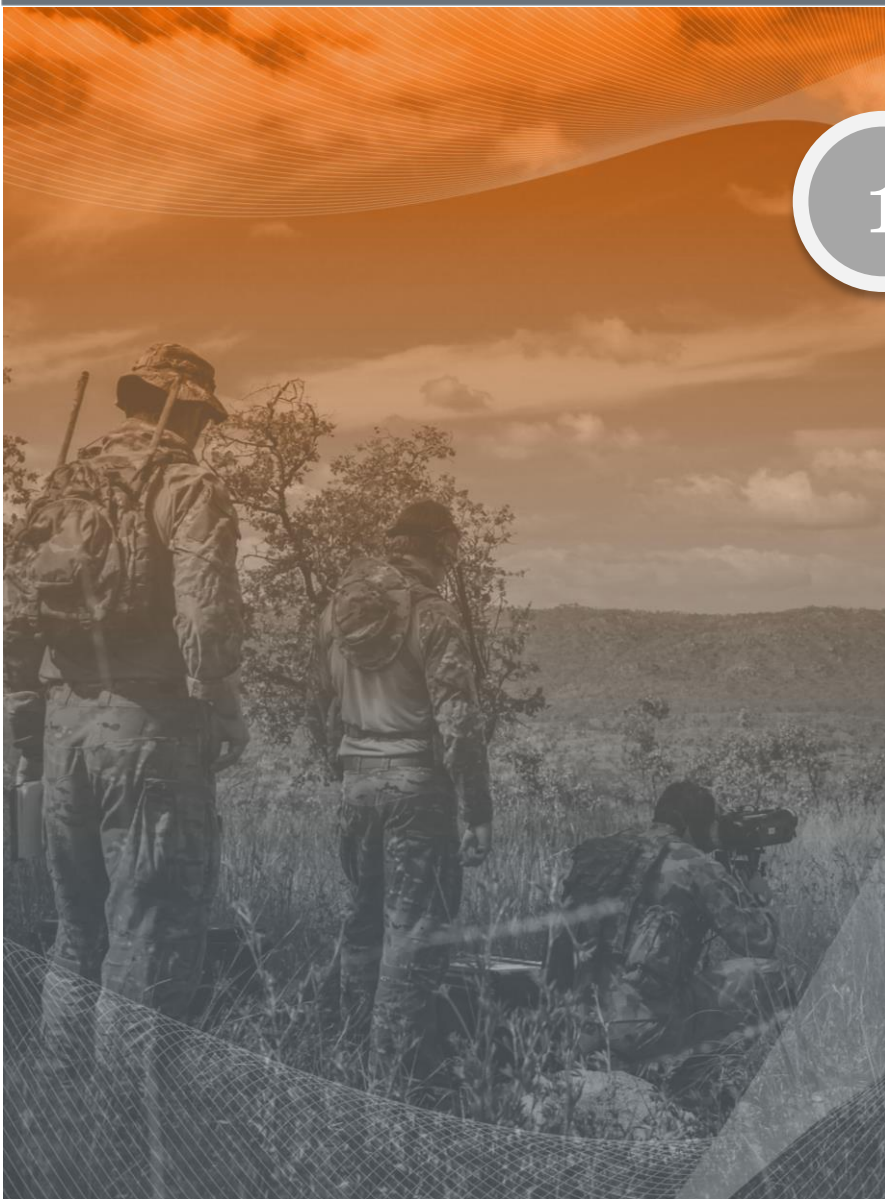

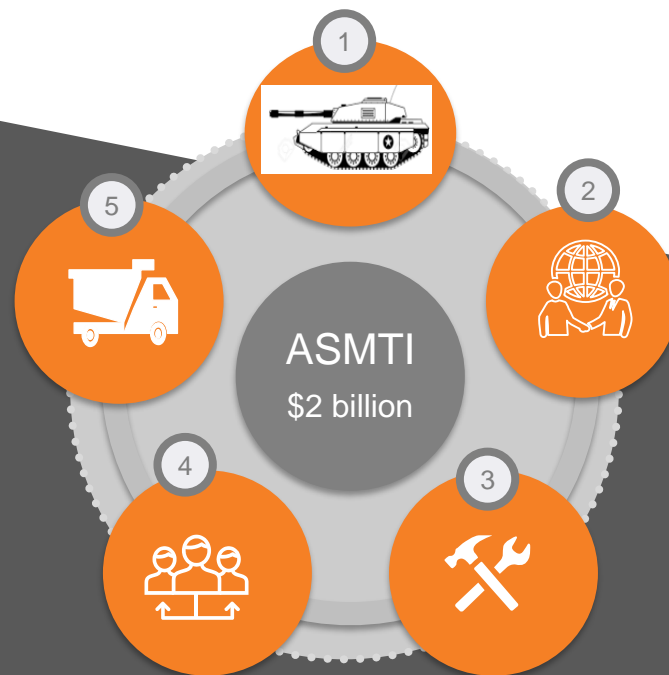

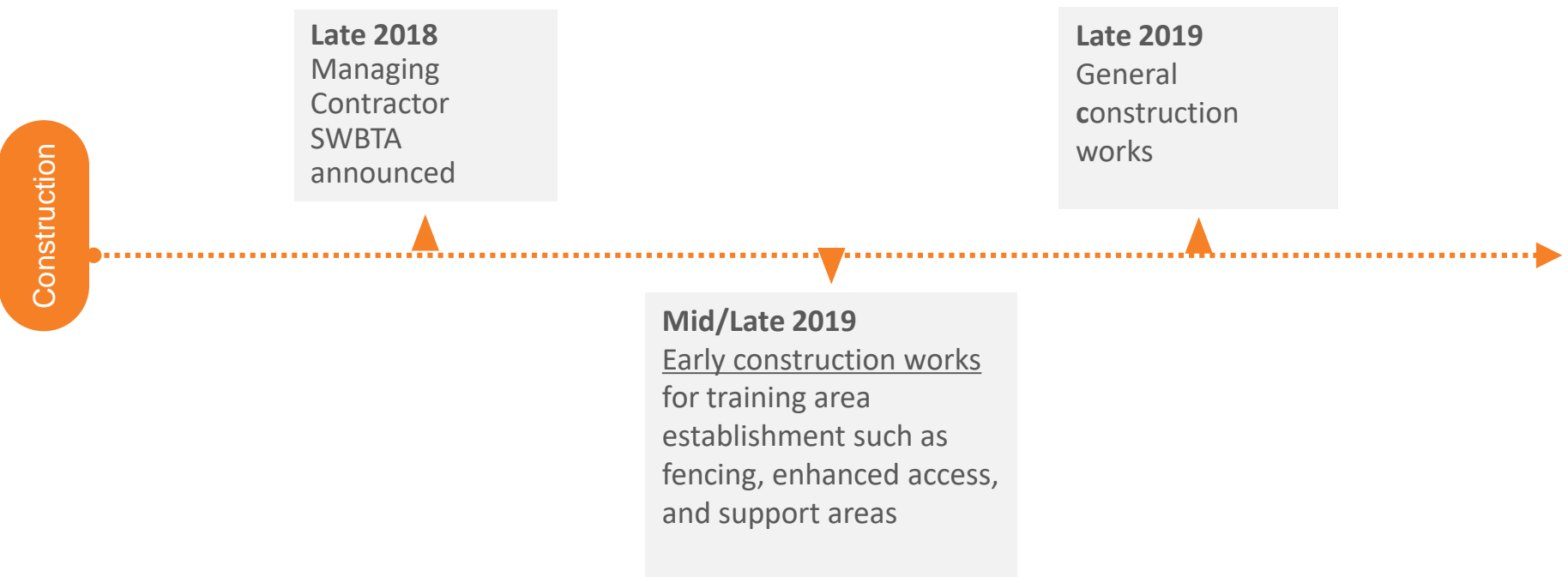
Defence is committed to engaging local businesses through Industry Briefings.

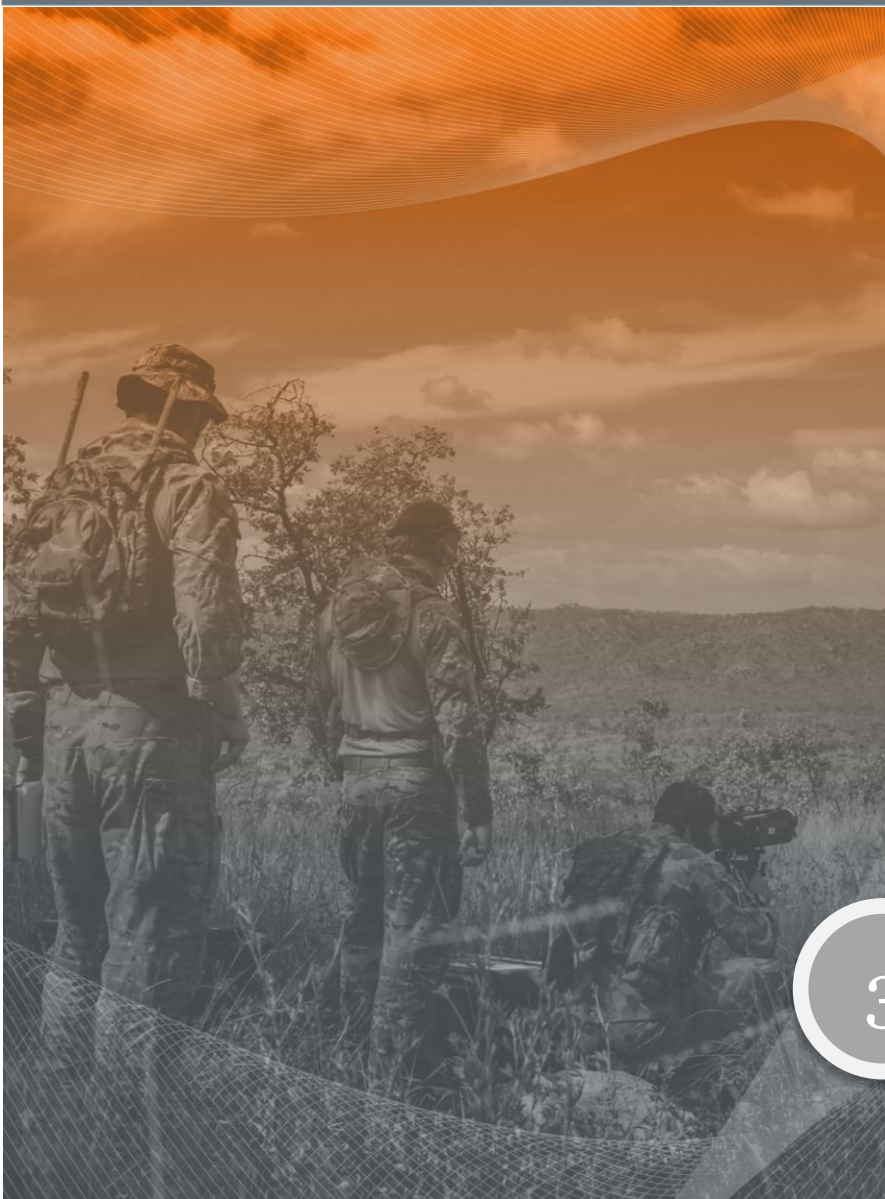
Most recent Contracting and Compliance Industry Brief held in Rockhampton 10 October 2018.

Defence will continue to keep Industry updated on upcoming works and briefings.

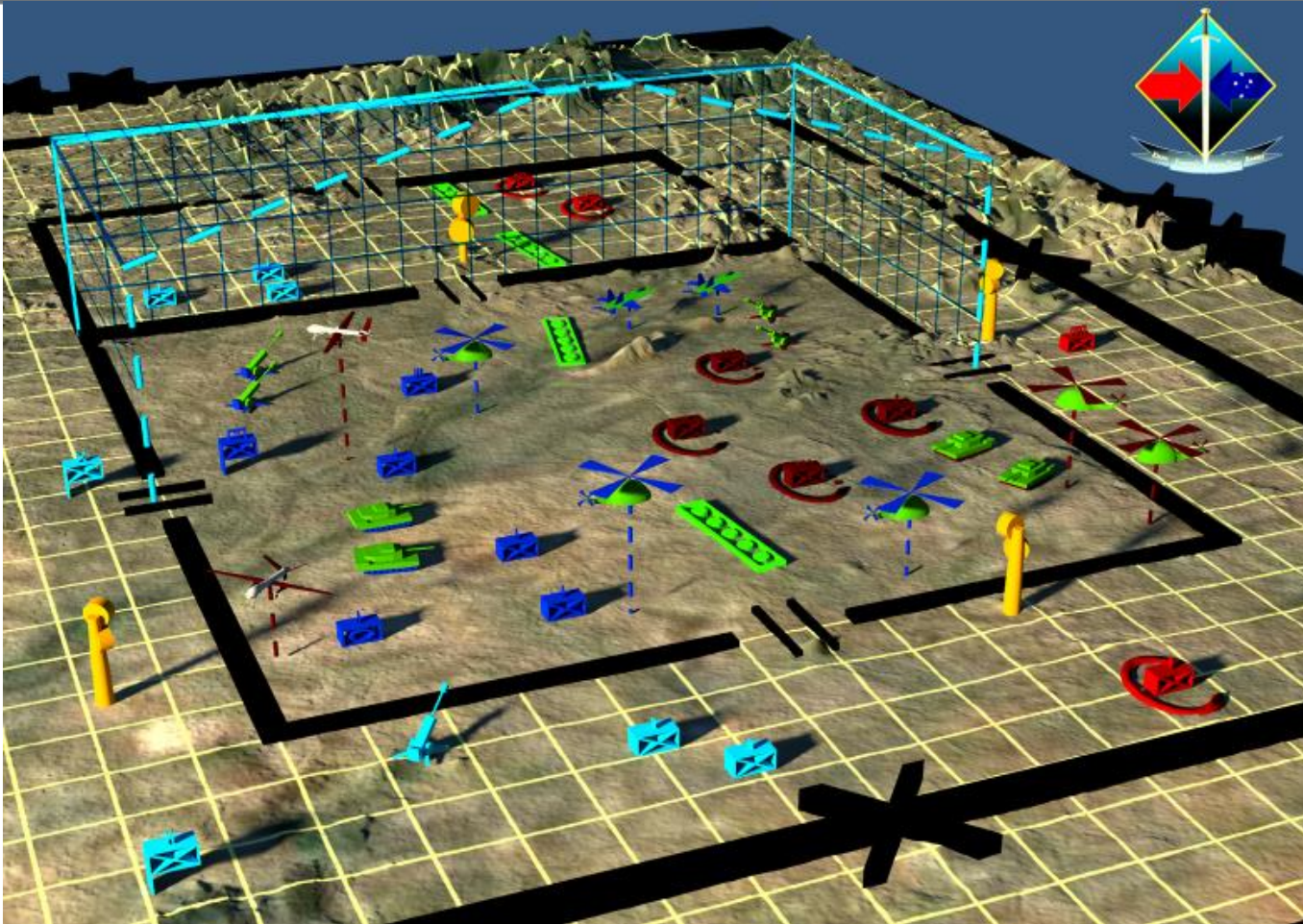

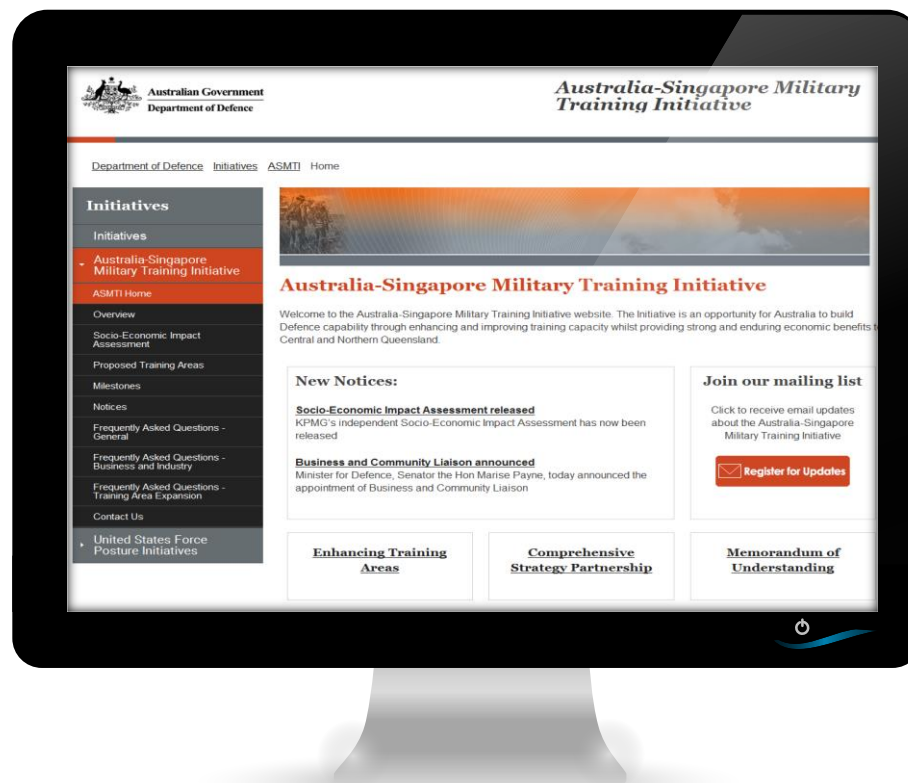
