


Project objectives

- Rookwood Weir will improve water security and deliver new business opportunities for irrigators and industry in Livingstone Shire, Rockhampton and Gladstone.
- Once complete the project will make available approximately 76,000 ML per annum of water.
- Sunwater is committed to working closely with local industry to facilitate business opportunities through construction, wherever possible.



Current status

- A budget allocation of \$352.2million is committed to Rookwood Weir.
- The Australian and Queensland Governments are funding the project on a 50:50 basis.
- Sunwater is currently progressing early works including:
 - Primary approval conditions and secondary approvals
 - Road upgrades (Gogango intersection and Thirsty Creek Road).
 - Investigations around local procurement of construction materials



Proposed project timings

- Design (85%) complete
- Design (100%) mid 2019
- Thirsty Creek Road mid 2019 to end 2019
- Gogango Intersection Upgrade mid 2019 to end 2019
- Weir and Bridges mid 2019 to 2023
 - Construction tender for main works package: Multi-stage process Industry briefing, EOI, select tender, final negotiation, award
 - EOI currently scheduled for mid-2019.
 - Contract award, site establishment and construction start (in river) 2020
 - Construction completion, weir commissioning and operations Early 2023

Local focus

- Project has obligations as a result of the Queensland Procurement Policy, Queensland Charter for Local Content and the Australian Industry Participation Policy.
- Focused on creating opportunities for local businesses.
- Opportunities to be engaged on the project may come directly (contractors) from Sunwater or indirectly (as a subcontractor) via the appointed contractor(s) of relevant works packages.
- Proposed to source majority of workforce from regional area.
- 15% of total construction hours to be undertaken by apprentices and/or trainees and through workforce training.
