



### Maximising opportunities for local industry

### **Local Industry Capability Plans**

- Companies tendering for work with Defence are required to outline how they will maximise the opportunity for local industry participation.
- This helps ensure local businesses can take full advantage of the opportunities arising from Defence projects.



### Local industry involvement

#### **Australia-Singapore Military Training Initiative**

#### **Central Queensland**

 26 companies participating in design and early construction works valued at \$27 million.

#### North Queensland:

- A Charters Towers company won a \$750,000 contract to deliver initial fencing and signage work.
- 90 per cent of contractors who worked on the \$5.4 million explosive ordnance facility at Mt Stuart were from the Townsville region.

#### 2. Download

Download the Market Sounding Information Response Form from AusTender.



#### 3. Complete

Complete all requested sections in the Market Sounding Information Response Form, including preparing a separate document detailing relevant experience.



#### 4. Submit

Submit your completed Market Sounding Information Response Form, including an attachment detailing relevant experience, to
