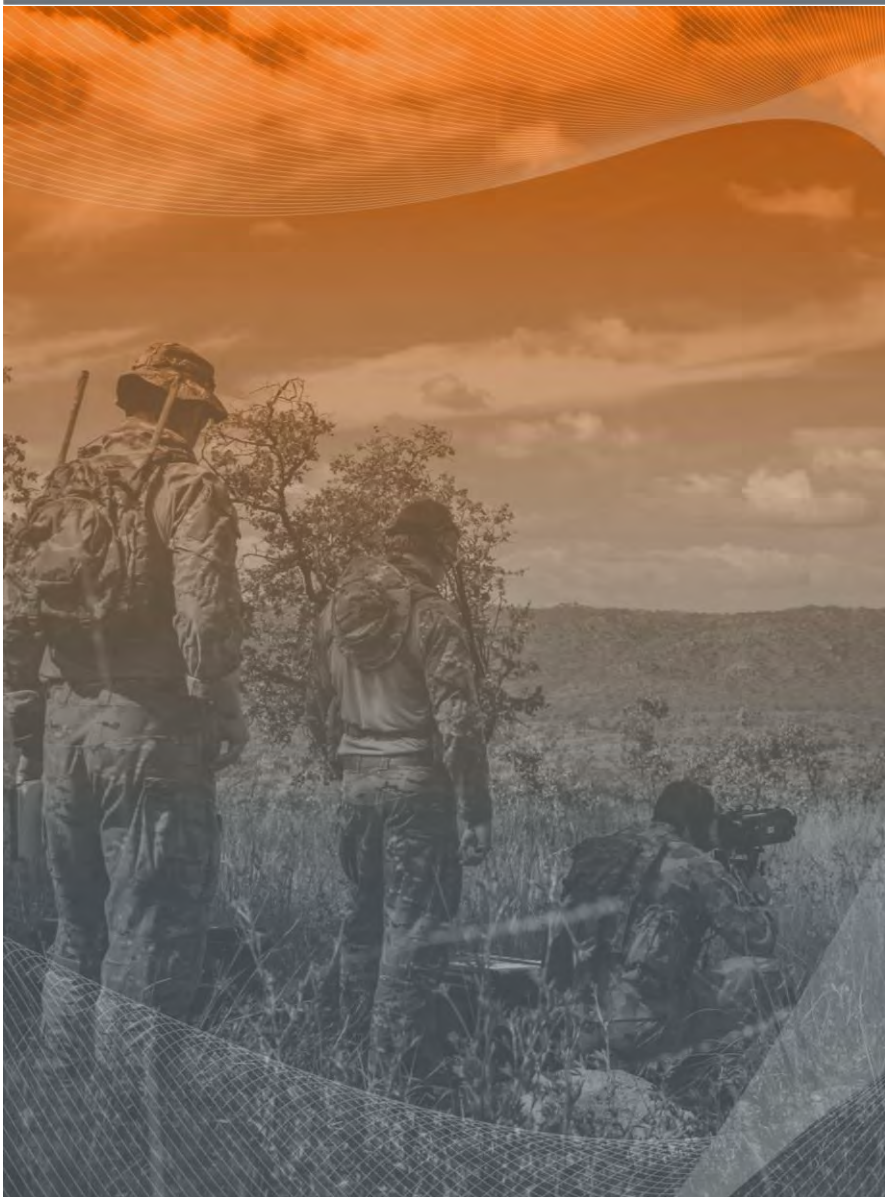

in **Central Queensland** is being expanded



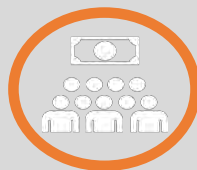
a new training area is being established near **Greenvale** in **North Queensland**

So far, 4 companies engaged for works and services for the Greenvale Early Works component



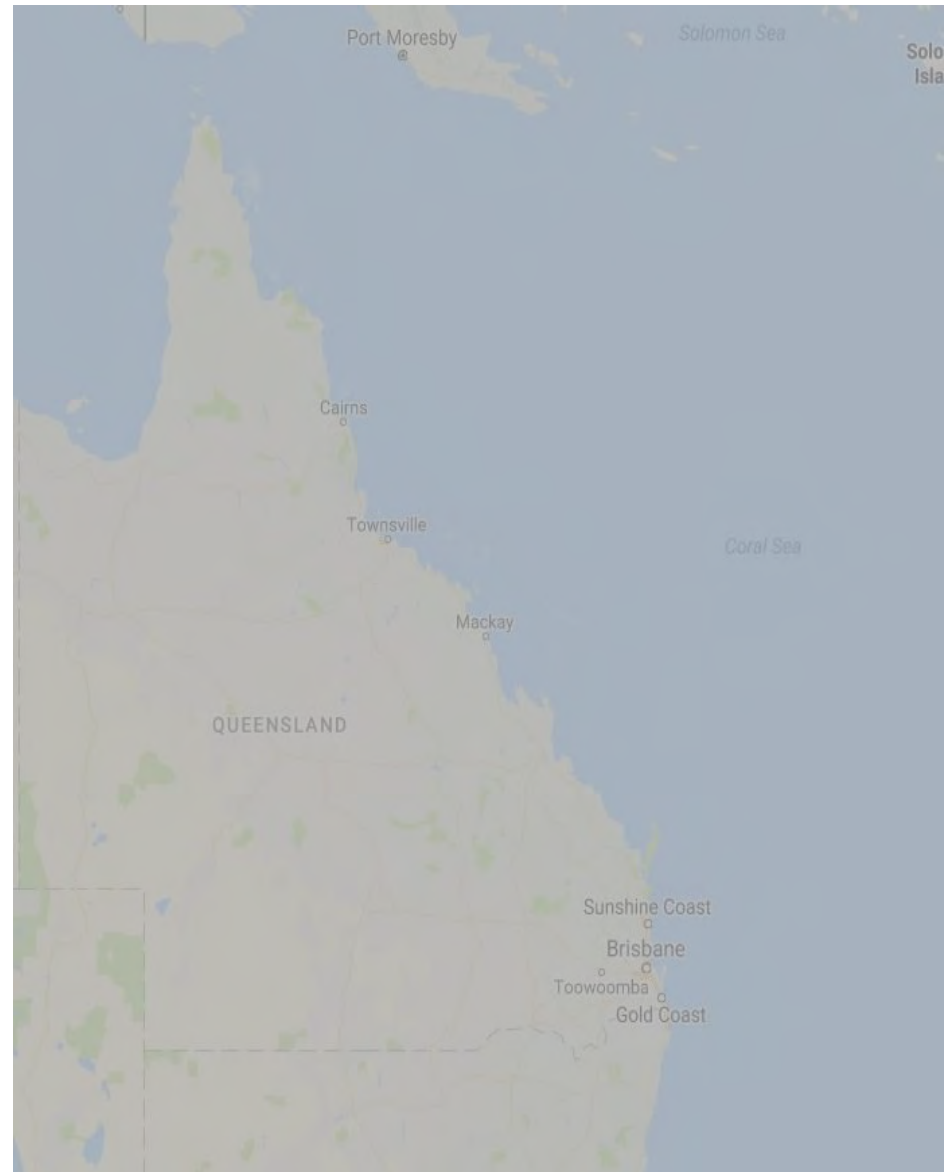
Additional Early Works packages will be delivered between 2020 and 2022
