



LANDRY CELEBRATES HISTORIC 10 YEARS AS CAPRICORNIA MP

Hard working Federal Member for Capricornia, Michelle Landry, today celebrates 10 years since her historic win to take back the seat of Capricornia for the Liberal National Party in 2013.

Over the past decade, Michelle Landry has delivered over \$6 billion in funding for vital infrastructure projects across the electorate which has created economic growth for the region.

The dedicated MP said she was proud of what she has achieved for her community.

“I have fought tirelessly to make Capricornia the best place in Australia to live and work. Since my election in 2013, I have delivered more than \$6 billion in funding for infrastructure and key projects.

“When I was elected, I promised the constituents of Capricornia that I would fight for their share and I believe I have kept this promise.

“Some projects that have really created the biggest impact on our communities have included the \$7 million I secured for the Rockhampton Hospital carpark, \$425,000 Collinsville QCWA Hall upgrade, \$183.6 million for Rookwood Weir, \$10 million for Yeppoon Foreshore redevelopment, over \$230,000 for Clermont Kindergarten and almost \$1 million for Multicap’s new assisted living facility in Rockhampton,” Ms Landry said.

Community organisations have also benefited greatly from the advocacy of Michelle Landry, with millions of dollars of funding flowing to improve facilities and equipment.

“It’s important that investment is made into community organisations and not-for-profits which are the backbone of our society.

“I’m incredibly proud of the millions of dollars I’ve secured for these organisations in my 10 years as the Member for Capricornia.

“One such project which I am immensely proud of is the Collinsville QCWA Hall redevelopment. When the woman of the Collinsville branch approached me to help them to replace their old asbestos ridden hall, it was a no brainer. These halls are the epicentre for any rural community and provide a space for more than just CWA meetings. In just a few weeks I am excited to be attending the official opening of the hall,” Ms Landry said.

Michelle credits the love and support of her family for getting her to where she is today.

“I want to thank my supporters but in particular my loving family for their support over the past 13 years.

“My Mum, Gloria, and late father, Bill, daughters Kirstin and Jessica, son-in-law Tim and my beautiful grandson, Fitzwilliam, thank you. Thank you for your love and the sacrifice which you all have had to make for me to be where I am today.”
