Project overview snapshot

Rosslyn Bay State Boat Harbour is one of eight state-owned boat harbours managed by Maritime Safety Queensland. Located on the Capricorn Coast, it provides all-tide, sheltered deep-water access for recreational and commercial vessels and supports recreational boating, commercial fishing, marine businesses, tourism and access to Great Keppel Island (Woppa).

Maritime Safety Queensland has prepared the Rosslyn Bay State Boat Harbour draft Master Plan (draft Master Plan) to establish a long-term direction for the future planning, use and management of the harbour.

What is the draft Master Plan?

The draft Master Plan is a long-term strategic planning document that establishes a shared vision and strategic direction for Rosslyn Bay State Boat Harbour. It provides a framework to guide the future planning, use and management of the harbour and identifies opportunities to support its future as demand and activity continue to grow.

The draft Master Plan has been informed by technical investigations, specialist analysis and stakeholder input. It includes a vision, strategic directions and a concept plan that together describe the long-term direction for the harbour and support future planning and decision-making.

The draft Master Plan includes:

- **A long-term vision:** Describes the future direction for Rosslyn Bay State Boat Harbour.
- **Five strategic directions:** Sets the priorities that guide future planning and decision-making.
- **A concept Master Plan:** Illustrates the future opportunities identified across the harbour.
- **Harbour precincts:** Describes the intended role, function and future direction of different areas.
- **Public infrastructure opportunities:** Identifies projects to improve access, safety, movement, parking, and public spaces.
- **Implementation approach:** Outlines how initiatives will be investigated, prioritised and progressed over time.

Next steps

The community are invited to review the draft Master Plan and provide feedback through the online survey.

Community drop-in sessions will also be held during the public feedback period where people can learn more about the draft Master Plan, ask questions and speak with the project team.

All feedback will be considered alongside the technical investigations. The final Rosslyn Bay State Boat Harbour Master Plan is expected to be completed in late 2026.
